As you are aware by now, on Tuesday 17th March Motorsport UK took the decision to withdraw all permits until the end of April 2020. At that point, we confirmed that the Manx Classic 2020 was cancelled and we stopped accepting entries.

Under H30.1.2(a) of the Motorsport UK Yearbook, you have the right to a refund of your entry fees paid in respect of the event. We would also like to offer you the option to transfer your entry to the Manx Classic 2021, and will give you some time to consider your options. Please email Bill at entries@manxmotorracingclub.com when you decide whether to;

1. Transfer your entry to the Manx Classic 2021. The entry fee paid this year will be held towards the 2021 entry fee. We will invoice you for the difference once the 2021 fees are set.
or
2. You can request a partial refund if you would you like make a donation to help our administrative costs (as suggested by one of the competitors).
or
3. Request a full refund.

If we haven't heard from you by 7pm on **Sunday 10th May 2020** we will begin initiating refunds via the same method you used to enter; debit/credit card or cheque. Please note that due to fees levied by our bank, we cannot make Faster Payments or BACS payments.
